BACKGROUND / HISTORY

The Grapevine Church of Christ has roots that date back to the earliest years of the city, meeting in homes in the early 1880's and moving into its first building in 1884.

As the city and surrounding areas have stretched and grown, so has our congregation. In 1980, the church bought six acres of land on the current location and built a 300-seat auditorium, offices and classrooms. In 2000 a new, larger auditorium was built, and the original building was remodeled to give the church a large fellowship hall in addition to the existing classrooms.

A significant number of our current members have ministered here at Grapevine as far back as the 1950s, participating in bus ministries, local benevolence such as closet and food pantries, and even a children's TV program carried on local cable networks. There are a large number of newly transplanted families at Grapevine, and a constantly strong youth group. Connecting the body and building relationships through small group fellowships, bible studies, and service opportunities, known as *Groups@Grapevine* has been a primary focus of our leadership for the past two years.

Today, the Grapevine church is a diverse body of approximately 225 members. Although we collectively serve in the areas listed on the following pages; we are also blessed with many individuals who quietly minister in significant ways to local schools, orphanages, prisons, urban ministries, and overseas benevolence efforts.



AREAS OF FOCUSED SERVICE

Community Outreach – The Grapevine Church of Christ continually seeks ways to engage those around us through charity, support, and ministry:

Grapevine Christian School

Our preschool was opened in 1982 and has been in continuous operation for 35+ years. For the past 5-7 years, each semester has been at full capacity based on available room space.

re:generation

Re:generation is 12-step discipleship through recovery. Our members are training to partner with people who are seeking healing, recovery, and freedom. The re:generation ministry is slated to begin in 2021 at Grapevine, and may involve the children's ministry program.

FriendSpeak

Utilizing the Word of God as the learning platform, we seek to build eternal relationships.

Annual Coat Giveaway

Our annual Coat Giveaway is an outreach that provided warm coats, blankets and gloves to nearly 1,500 people in the Grapevine community in 2019-2020.

Main Street Church of Christ

We reach the homeless in partnership with the Main Street Church of Christ in downtown Dallas with clothing, food, and fellowship.

Orphanage / Foster Parent Support

We provide support both financially, through food drives, and service days for Christ's Haven for Children (Keller, TX).

Fall Festival

Our Fall Festival is geared toward reaching children and families in the Grapevine area through an evening of fun, fellowship and food.

Mens' and Ladies' Ministries

Both mens' and ladies' ministries provide regular opportunities to fellowship, encourage, and serve with kindred spirits

Youth Ministry

The youth of our congregation participate in short-term mission work, local outreach, fellowship activities, and in regular in-home bible studies.

AREAS OF FOCUSED SERVICE

Global Missions - The Grapevine Church of Christ physically, prayerfully, and financially supports the following efforts:

Nicaragua

Grapevine is the overseeing congregation for Mision Para Cristo (Benny and Donna Baker) and their multiple humanitarian and evangelistic efforts in central Nicaragua. Multiple delegations from our church travel each year in support of outreach programs and service projects in and around Jinotega. Grapevine also collects materials throughout the year for the thousands of Christmas gift boxes given to the needy children of central Nicaragua.

Travis & Mindy Stewart

Travis & Mindy Stewart are lifelong Texans embarking on a journey to serve the people of Nicaragua. They work with Misión Para Cristo in Nicaragua and utilize his gifts of business, construction, and agriculture and her skills as a licensed Family Nurse Practitioner to further the work of the Holy Spirit there.

Evangelists in Ivano-Frankivsk, Donetsk, and Simferopol, Ukraine

The Grapevine Church of Christ supports the growing bodies of believers in specific cities in Ukraine as well as sending annual representatives to Ukraine to show support, teach, and assist with seminars for the gathering bodies there.








THE COMMUNITY

The city of Grapevine and the nearby suburbs in the north Dallas-Fort Worth metroplex area are widely considered to be among the best places to live in the United States.

Grapevine itself is centrally located between Dallas and Fort Worth and is located right on the northern edge of the Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport. Its proximity to the airport and the larger DFW metro area makes Grapevine a growing hub for international commerce, conventions, and destination/tourism activities. 


